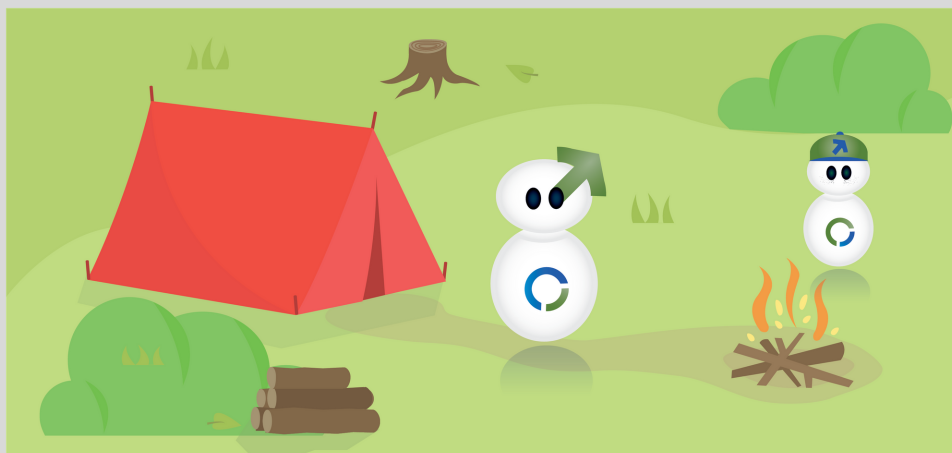

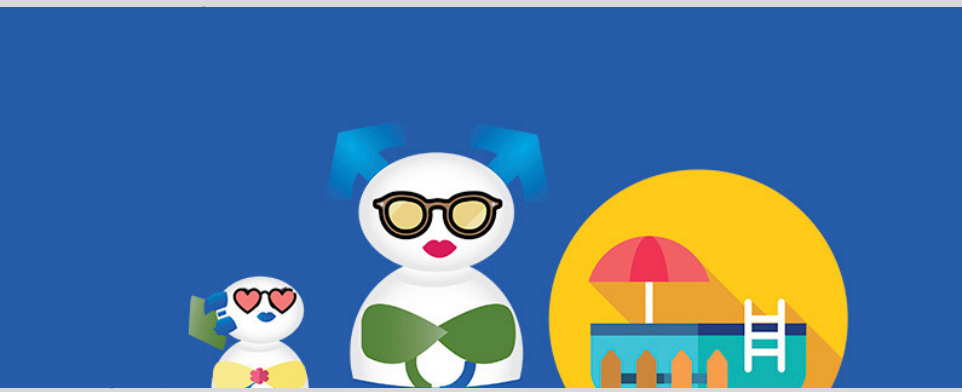

LOOKOUT FOR SAFETY IN THE FACILITIES

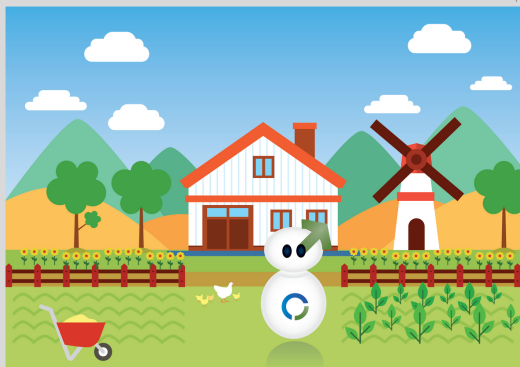
